About ACLGIM

The Association of Chiefs and Leaders of General Internal Medicine (ACLGIM) provides a professional home for general internists who are leaders, or who aspire to become leaders, within academic and/or clinical medicine. ACLGIM members include division and section chiefs, program directors, directors of research and educational programs as well as hospital, health system, policy and governmental leaders.

History and Mission of ACLGIM

Founded as the Association of Chiefs in General Internal Medicine (ACGIM) in 2000, ACLGIM began as a direct result of SGIM's desire to address the increasing complexity faced by primary care physicians, educators, hospitalists and researchers as they took on additional responsibility within their organizations. This desire manifested itself in the form of SGIM steering committee in 2000 which in turn created the subgroup organizations ACGIM. This new organization identified and pursued the following four goals:

- Provide professional development through leadership and management training;
- Provide forums in which to exchange information;
- Provide personal development and networking for Chiefs and leaders;
- Influence and educate institutional leaders about issues relevant to academic GIM;

In 2010, ACGIM expanded their scope to include "leaders" within GIM. This natural expansion was due to the parallels between the classic position of division chiefs and ever-evolving use of organizational leaders within health systems. Today, the renamed Association of Chiefs and Leaders in General Internal Medicine (ACLGIM) still strives to address the four initial goals as well as fostering diversity in GIM leadership and bolstering relationships among division and associate chiefs, clinical directors, hospital and research directors, mentors and other GIM leaders.
