ACLGIM seeks candidates to serve as a member of the Editorial Board for the ACLGIM Leadership Forum.

The ACLGIM Leadership Forum is the quarterly publication of ACLGIM, which updates and informs leaders in General Medicine of healthcare policy trends and management skills useful in their leadership roles in academic medicine, clinical care, research and teaching. Drs. Sunil Sahai, Rita Lee, and Lauren Block make up the Editorial Board. Each member of the Editorial Board rotates as Chief Editor for one year, for a total of three years.

The role encompasses:

With the Editor and Associate Editor, **guide and secure the quarterly publication of the Forum** (about 4 articles/ issue; 2,000 words total/ issue). The issues are released quarterly (March, June, September, December). The March and December issues feature articles from speakers at the Hess Institute and Winter Summit, respectively; the June and December issues also feature an article from the ACLGIM president.

ACLGIM Executive Board and SGIM Regional leaders will assist with identifying and contributing pieces for this column. Over the three-year term, the board member will rotate through the associate editor and editor positions. **This is an exciting opportunity to interact with leaders in general internal medicine and gain experience writing and editing for a national audience.**
