CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

We announce this Call for Nominations for the Award for Excellence in Clinical Education. The awards are intended primarily for individuals in the early phase of their careers (e.g. Instructors or Assistant professors), but individuals in mid-career with a new or recent focus on medical education may also apply. The nominee must be a member or associate member of SGIM.

The **Southern Society of General Internal Medicine Award for Excellence in Clinical Education** is intended to highlight outstanding **Clinician Educators** in our region. The award is given to individuals who are working towards developing their careers as Clinician Educators. Specifically, the Committee will look for individuals who:

- 1) Are early or mid-career Clinician Educators (at or below the rank of Assistant Professor)
- 2) Are active members of SGIM at the regional level
- 3) Have displayed innovation and excellence in teaching and/or in the delivery of clinical care

Nomination & Application process:

Nominations will be accepted from SGIM members familiar with the candidate for this award. Eligible individuals are welcome to nominate themselves.

The application will consist of the following items:

1. CV
2. Letter of nomination from an SGIM member that includes reason for nomination
3. Letter from division chief (who may/may not be an SGIM member)

All nominations will be reviewed by the Awards Selection Committee. Award winners will be notified in late December. Awards will be presented at the annual Southern Society of General Internal Medicine Regional Meeting on **February 3-4, 2023**. We look forward to the continuation of the annual recognition of prominent leaders in our field, and hope your institution identifies candidates for nomination.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Society of General Internal Medicine announces a call for nominations to honor mid-level and senior members of Regional SGIM who have contributed meaningfully to SGIM and whose work has advanced generalism. This award, entitled the Southern Society of General Internal Medicine Award for Leadership, is intended to provide recognition to mid-level and senior-level SGIM members and promote continued participation and contributions to regional SGIM from long-standing SGIM members. Recipients will be recognized at the regional SGIM meeting.

Who is eligible for the Award for Leadership?

This award is intended for current SGIM members who have been active members of regional SGIM for at least 8-10 years; however, a minimum number of years as an SGIM member are not required. Researchers, educators, clinicians, and administrators are all eligible.

Awards will be made to nominees who best meet the following criteria:

- 1) Have contributed to the mission of SGIM
- 2) Work is recognized as advancing academic general internal medicine
- 3) Actively support and participate in SGIM regional activities

Examples include individuals recognized as role models and educators at their institutions, individuals with significant leadership or administrative roles at their institutions, researchers whose work has advanced generalism, and individuals with demonstrated leadership in other academic endeavors or organizations that enhance academic general internal medicine.

Nomination & Application process:

Nominations will be accepted from SGIM members familiar with the candidate for this award. Eligible individuals are welcome to nominate themselves.

The application will consist of the following items:

1. CV
2. Letter of nomination from an SGIM member that includes reason for nomination
3. Letter from division chief (who may/may not be an SGIM member)

Call for Applications

We announce the Call for Applications for the Annual Southern SGIM Leadership Development Award. These awards are intended to assist early career faculty in developing leadership skills and a stronger connection with Southern SGIM.

Awardees will be expected to attend and participate in the Southern SGIM Regional Meeting. Specific participation will be based on the interest and strengths of the awardees, but may include session moderation, vignette judging, and participation in mentoring. Awardees will have additional opportunity for leadership development through a position on the planning committee for the Southern SGIM meeting in 2023.

Eligibility

1. Current SGIM membership
2. Active members of Southern SGIM: active members have attended and/or presented work at the regional meeting at least once in the last 5 years
3. Have an interest in becoming more involved in SGIM regional leadership but have not served in an SGIM leadership position previously.

We expect that awardees will be current faculty at or below the Assistant Professor level, but mid-career faculty who are newly active in Southern SGIM are welcome to apply.

Application Process

Applications will be accepted from eligible individuals directly and consist of:

1. Current CV, highlighting participation in Southern SGIM/National SGIM.
2. Letter of interest from the candidate, stating their prior involvement in Southern SGIM and their goals for leadership within the region.
3. Letter from division chief (or similar supervisor) that outlines support for faculty to attend the meeting and serve in SGIM leadership.

All nominations will be reviewed by the Awards Selection Committee. Award winners will be notified in late December. Awards will be presented at the annual Southern Society of General Internal Medicine Regional Meeting on February 3-4, 2023. We look forward to the continuation of the annual recognition of prominent leaders in our field, and hope your institution identifies candidates for nomination.
