

Call for Clinical Update Proposals for the 2026 SGIM New England Regional Meeting

The SGIM New England Planning Committee invites submissions for Clinical Updates to be presented at our upcoming regional meeting in November 2026. These updates serve as a focal point of our annual gathering, offering an overview of recent developments in key areas of interest to our audience.

Proposal Focus

Submissions may focus on:

- A specific **clinical topic** (e.g., community-acquired pneumonia, hypertension, prostate cancer screening)
- A **clinical specialty** (e.g., cardiology, endocrinology, geriatrics)
- A particular **clinical setting** (e.g., inpatient, outpatient)
- A **patient population** (e.g., underserved communities, older adults)
- **Technological advances**, including the role of AI

Regardless of the focus, presenters should plan for a **45- to 50-minute presentation geared toward attending-level physicians**. To ensure representation across career stages, our goal is for each update to be presented by speakers at different career stages (e.g., one early-career and one mid- to late-career). We welcome submissions from groups of presenters as well as from individual presenters, whom we would then group together. Cross-institutional collaboration is encouraged but not required.

Submission Criteria

1. **Title**
2. **Session Summary:** (limit: 3,000 characters, including spaces) Provide a concise overview of your content, including key articles or guidelines. *To ensure the most up-to-date content, please prioritize articles or guideline updates that were published within one year of the regional meeting (November 2025 or later).*
3. **Relevance of topic to SGIM Members**
4. **ACCME-Specific Learning Objectives:** (3 required) Each learning objective should reflect one of the six [ACCME Core Competencies](#)
5. **Subject Expertise:** Describe the presenters' expertise or experience in this content area
6. **Session Outcomes:** How will the session help participants learn key points and apply them?
7. **Innovation:** Does the Update bring a new topic or perspective to the conference?
8. **Session History:** Has this session been presented before? If yes, identify the meeting(s) and date(s)
9. **Product Approval:** Does your presentation reference/mention a product that is not approved in the United States for the use under discussion? Yes/No. If yes, explain
10. **Session Coordinator:** and up to four additional speakers (maximum: five total speakers)
11. **Category:** see list below: you must choose one, and only one

Presentation Preparation

- Presenters will be expected to meet with the Planning Committee in **September 2026** to review their overall approach and preliminary slides.
- **Final slides** must be submitted by **October 9th, 2026**, to allow for Continuing Education processing.
